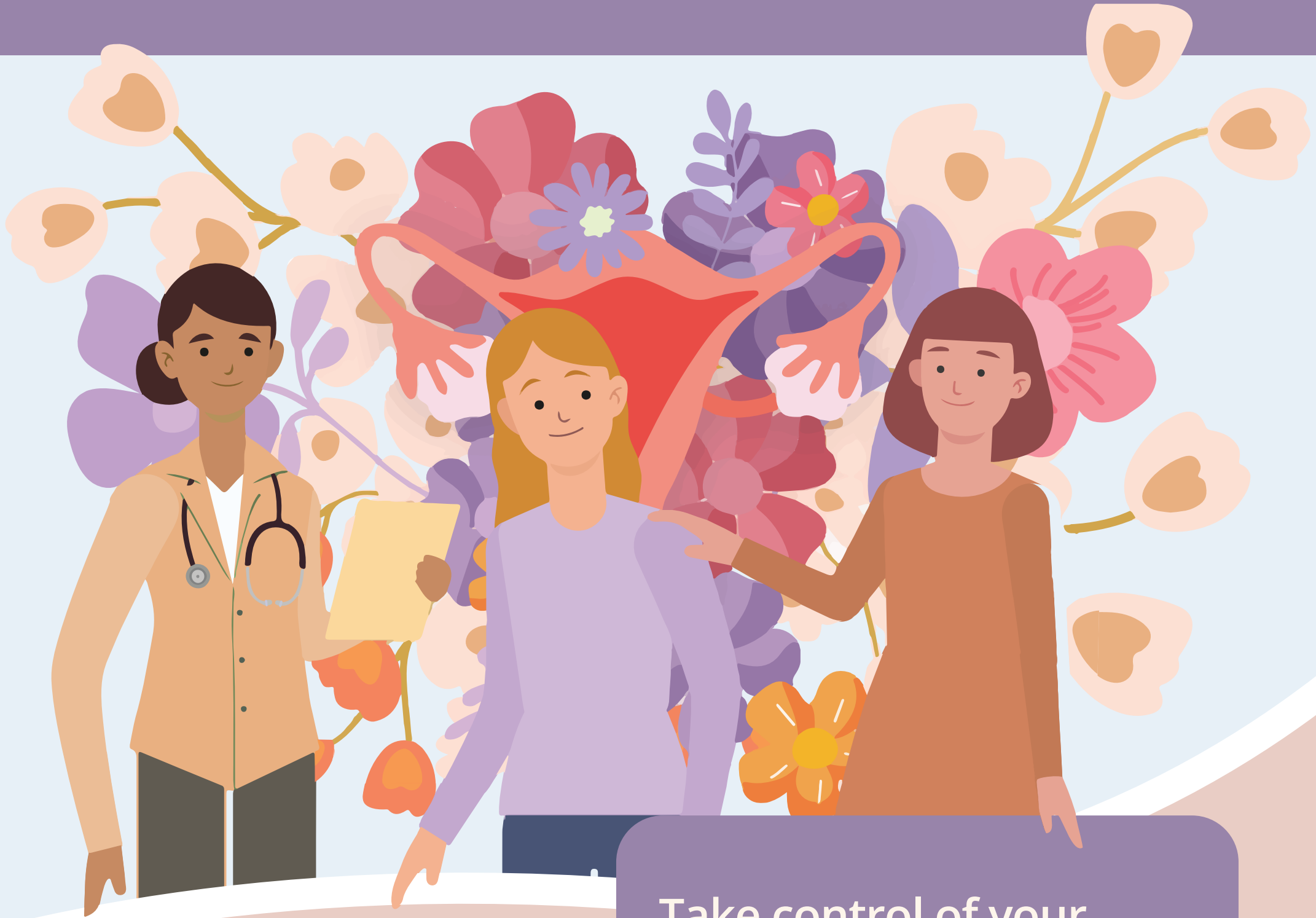

## LEARN ABOUT CERVICAL SCREENING SELF-COLLECTION



In Australia, more than **70% of people diagnosed with cervical cancer have never been screened or are not up to date with their cervical screening.**<sup>1</sup>

Cervical screening is recommended every five years for all women and persons with a cervix who are aged 25–74.
